

We are an interdenominational, non-political, grass-roots child advocacy group comprised of **church leaders** and **concerned citizens**.

Many of Zambia's orphans and vulnerable children grow up in orphanages.

We believe there is an alternative.

Where possible, a child should live in a loving family.

We are passionate about the church supporting children who need parental care.

We believe the church can make a difference.

Our aim is to recruit Christian families to foster and adopt our vulnerable children.

Embrace Zambia works with the Department of Social Welfare.

Why should children live in a family?

- ◆ Family is God's original design for children.

Embrace Zambia Project began in April 2014 when the first Christian Foster Parenting Retreat took place in Lusaka. Sixty-two families expressed an interest in welcoming a child in their home.
